#### **Your Commitment**

- Ensure we reach as many children as possible by delivering one-to-one reading sessions to support as many children as you are able
- Deliver two thirty-minute reading sessions a week, across six weeks
- Commit to delivering all twelve reading sessions in your programme and only cancel sessions in exceptional and unforeseen circumstances (such as illness)
- Complete at least three reading programmes a year and we'd love you to do more so we can support as many children as possible
- Deliver fun, impactful reading sessions to ignite the joy of reading in children using the training, guidance and resources provided by Bookmark
- Provide Bookmark with feedback about the programme and your experience as a volunteer

- Fluent in English and a competent reader
- A good communicator with excellent listening skills

- · Trustworthy with a friendly manner
- Reliable, punctual and committed to each reading programme
- Able to work professionally and collaboratively with others

#### Safeguarding

- Complete all relevant checks in line with our <u>Safer Recruitment Policy</u> to ensure suitability to work with children
- Ensure your DBS check is registered on the DBS Update Service. If it is not, this must be renewed every 3 years
- Understand that it is an offence to apply for this role if you are barred from engaging in regulated activity relevant to children
- Safeguard and promote the wellbeing and welfare of the children you are responsible for, or come into contact with, in accordance with Bookmark's safeguarding policies and procedures
- If you have any concerns about the safety or wellbeing of a child, you have a duty to report these concerns, so the right people can help
- Report safeguarding concerns as outlined in the safeguarding policies and procedures
- Share and adhere to Bookmark's commitment to safeguarding and promoting the well-being and welfare of children

- Complete initial online training package, including safeguarding
- · Refresh your safeguarding training as required
- Engage with additional Bookmark training resources and other opportunities to develop your skills and build your knowledge
- Complete other necessary training updates as required
- Ask for and provide support and learnings to other volunteers through our online community
